

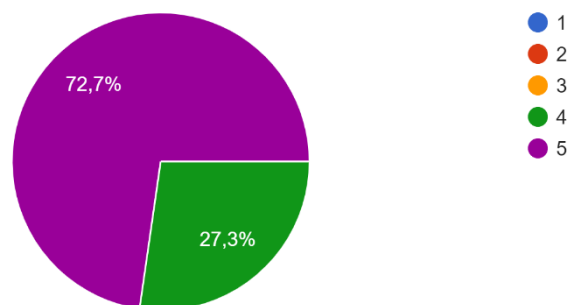

## Job evaluation - intellectual results

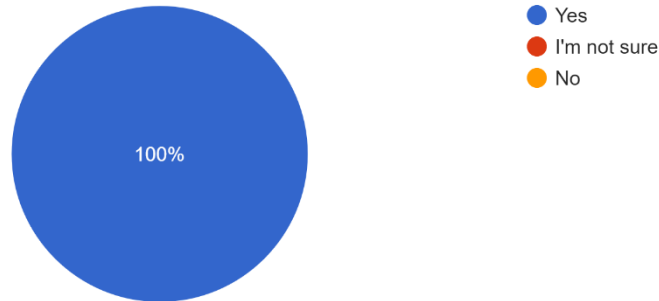
How would you rate your contribution to the work on intellectual results? 1 is the minimum contribution, 5 is the maximum.

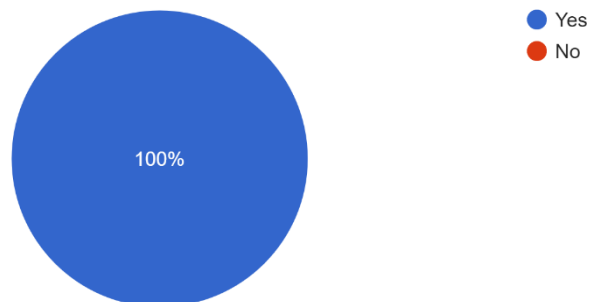
Working out which topic was the most difficult for you?

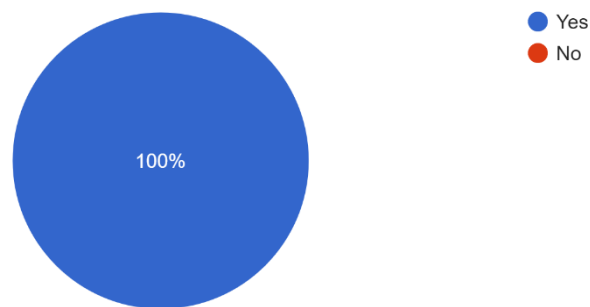
Have you analyzed the results of the student surveys?

### **Give some reflections on the analysis of teacher surveys.**

Teachers are fairly well versed in the dangers of using the internet. Some of them fell victim to Internet crimes.

Surprisingly, teachers admit that they rarely talk to their students about internet safety.

Some teachers do not know the risks of using links from unfamiliar senders.

Not all teachers are aware of the dangers of publishing their photos on the Internet.

I was surprised to learn that not all teachers care about the privacy settings on their social profiles.

It is surprising that among teachers there are people who admit people they do not know to their group of friends on social networking sites, regardless of possible dangers.

A large group of teachers do not think about security when shopping online.

Not all teachers remember to update their antivirus programs.

Although teachers are negligent in using the Internet safely, they believe that they are well informed about online safety.

I think teachers need training related to internet safety. Their knowledge is incomplete.

## Give some reflections on the student of student surveys.

The surveys confirmed that students spend a lot of time on the Internet. They mainly use social media, rarely use educational sites.

The students have encountered various types of threats on the Internet, they are aware of them, but do not feel particularly threatened on the Internet. It's puzzling.

A large group of teenagers communicate with people they only know online.

Some teenagers meet people they meet online and do not consider it a threat.

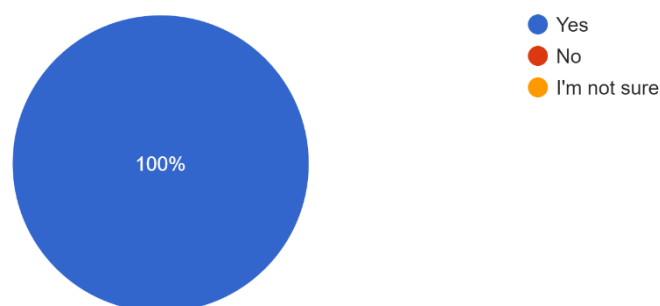
It is shocking that some teenagers talk online with strangers about private, intimate matters.

It happens that students share their address and contact details with strangers.

Teenagers declare that they know how to use the Internet safely, but their online behavior can be risky.

Everyone analyzed the results of the questionnaires for teachers and students.

The analysis of these surveys showed members of the project team that both teachers and students declare that they have a lot of knowledge about safe use of the Internet, and yet engage in risky behavior on the Internet. The rules for safe Internet use are not mentioned often enough at school. All this points to the need to create new tools and materials that would promote the idea of safety on the Internet.
